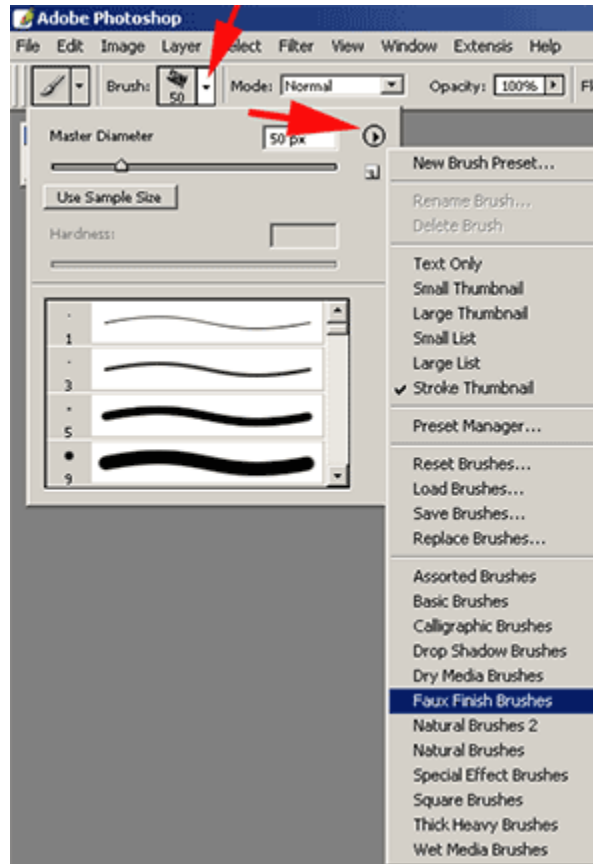


**EZ EDGES** – This works the same in Elements

1. Open an image. Create a new BLANK Layer above your background.
2. Open the Brushes Palette and choose a rough edge art brush such as one of the Chalk brushes. If you don't see one, you can load more brushes. With the Brush Tool active in the Toolbar, go to the top toolbar and click down on the little arrow to the right of the word "Brush". Next, click on the arrow to the right to reveal more options. You will see a list of more available brushes. You can only choose one group at a time so if you want to try all of them, just repeat the previous.



3. With your artsy rough edge brush, paint with WHITE around the edge of your image. You usually only need to have the very edge of your brush on the image.



That's all there is to it!

**TIP:** Because your "edge" is on a separate layer, you can add layer styles for more creativity.
