**IMAGE TO SKETCH** – This is one of the first tutorials I learned. It's fast and easy!

- 1. Open your image. Do a "save as" giving it a new name. You are now not working on your original.
- 2. Duplicate the background (Ctrl/Cmd + J). Turn this copy layer off by clicking the eye to left.
- 3. Click on the background and then "Image>Adjustment>Desaturate. You now have a B/W image.
- 4. Filter>Stylize>Find Edges Apply Levels to force more black and white as below right but don't make lines TOO strong as it may not give a pleasing result. You will need to experiment.



- 5. Now click on the Copy Layer and change the Blend Mode to "Color". Instant Sketch!
- 6. To bring back detail (eyes, etc), click on the Background. Use the History Brush at low opacity(Fig A)
- 7. Add Texture. Click on Filter>Texture>Texturizer. Choose from the list.


